


Little Girl

Oh no! The library has closed. I'm locked in!


Voices! Oh dear! I must hide!

Frog King: ...promises are easier to make than to keep.


Well... I like the new things you are doing. But I also love your old stories, too.

Yes! Make a brand-new story – with the old and the new.


Frog King: ...keep our promise to work together.


Cinderella: We'll keep that in mind. Good luck, Prince!

And so, our independent heroes ran and climbed their own path leaving one very puzzled prince behind.


Act 2: Scene 4: The Tricker's Clearing
